

# **OUR APPROACH**

To empower Navalites to be effective communicators and confident users of the English Language. We believe that language use is guided by an awareness of purpose, the audience, context and culture in which the communication is to take place.

# KEY PROGRAMMES

#### iRead@NBPS

IREAD@NBPS is an integrated English Language initiative designed to foster a love for reading and strengthen language skills across the curriculum. Through authentic reading experiences, students build a strong foundation in both oral and written communication. To build a reading culture, the school begins each day with 15 minutes of Sustained Silent Reading (SSR) before assembly.

We also support students' diverse learning needs through our Morning Reading Programme, held twice weekly. Allied Educators, Teacher Assistants, Learning Support Coordinators, teachers, and student leaders work together to provide targeted reading support.

For our younger learners in Primary 1 and 2, KidsREAD is held weekly. This programme supports students from financially disadvantaged backgrounds by immersing them in storytelling, engaging activities, and guided reading sessions with dedicated volunteers.



#### **English Fiesta**

La Fiesta is a week of fun-filled activities that spark our Navalites' love for the English language. From games and storytelling to songwriting and poetry, every level takes part in exciting language experiences.


Primary 1 and 2 Navalites share their favourite stories and enjoy a Character Walk with surprise features of teachers dressed up as famous book characters. Primary 3s explore poetry, while Primary 4s design creative movie posters. Our older Navalites in Primary 5 and 6 express themselves through poem and song-writing.



## LIBRARY ACTIVITIES

In line with our goal to develop confident English communicators, Primary 1 and 2 students take turns sharing stories at the school library — an opportunity to build confidence through public speaking.

For Primary 3 to 6 students, Thursdays are a time to shine as they showcase their talents in storytelling, acting, and singing. These sessions are a weekly highlight our students eagerly look forward to.



## **ADMIRAL'S PROGRAMME**

The English Admiral's Programme introduces students to classic literature, starting with Charlie and the Chocolate Factory (Primary 3) and Charlotte's Web (Primary 4). By Primary 5, students progress to exploring, appreciating and and creating poetry.
